



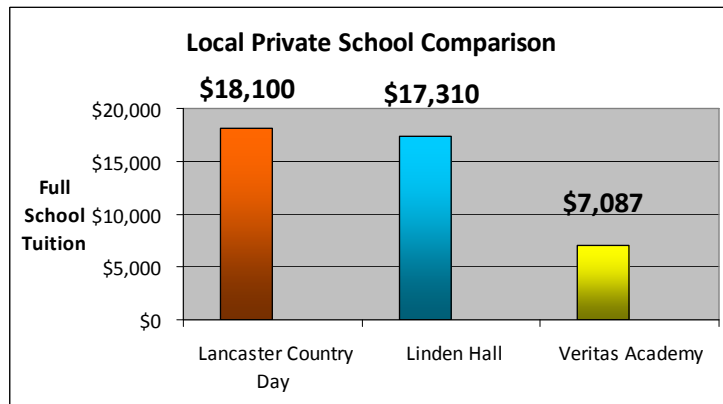
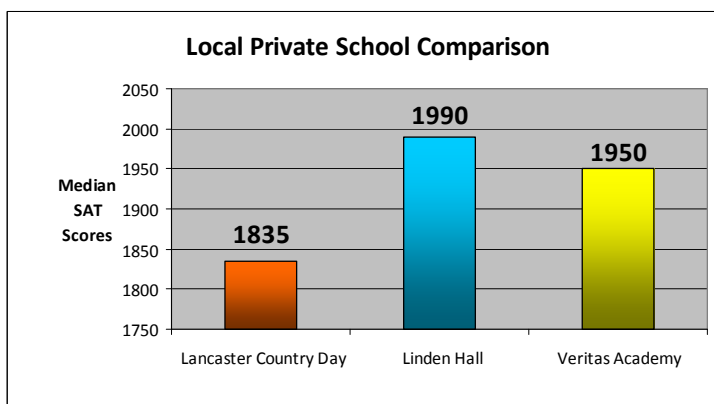
Dear Veritas Academy Parent,
